Subject: Smoking ban in workplaces, academic establishments, meeting halls, and theaters.

Reference: Appeal of the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports No. 455 dated February 13, 1998.

Pursuant to the above subject and reference, in order to effectively enforce the appeal for giving up cigarette smoking, the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports would like to request that all provincial/municipal departments and academic institutes and establishments which are under the Ministry should pay attention to raise awareness, so as to prevent cigarette smoking in shared workplace, meeting halls, and academic establishments.

Meanwhile, if provincial/municipal departments, academic institutes and establishments believe that it is impossible to eliminate cigarette smoking completely, it is requested that the smoking place be allocated for smokers, so as to avoid causing health impacts on other non-smokers. Also, provincial/municipal departments, academic institutes and establishments are requested to post pictures raising awareness on the health impacts of cigarette smoking.

The Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports hopes that you really pay attention and make efforts to implement this directive effectively.
